The main attraction of Baneपा is the temple of Chandeswor, located approximately 1 km (0.62 mi) northeast of the town along the Rudramati River. The Dhaneshwor Temple is 1 KM south of the town. Baneपा is also known for its eight different temples of Lord Ganesh, Narayankhan (the temple of Lord Narayan), Bhimsankhan (the temple of Lord Bhimsen) and eight different ponds.

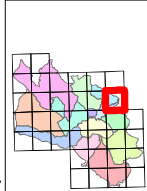
